

St. Louis County Jail, Duluth

- Built in 1923 as part of Duluth Civic Center Complex. Complex planned by architect Daniel Burnham as part of the “City Beautiful Movement.”
- Civic Center Complex listed in the National Register of Historic Places and a designated local landmark.
- Listed on Ten Most Endangered first in 1994. Jail has been empty since 1995.
- Reuse study completed in 1999 identified several potential uses, but there has been no implementation.
- St. Louis County officials have put forth a position paper that states the case for demolition.
- Building should be stabilized and actively marketed to a public or private investor using state grants or tax incentives.
